In 2021, the Government of Andhra Pradesh entered into a Power Sale Agreement (PSA) with SECI-Adani to purchase 7 GW of solar power. The current Finance Minister, Sri Payyavula Keshav, has alleged that the agreement will impose an undue financial burden of ₹1.2 lakh crore on the people of Andhra Pradesh. He has also filed a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) in the High Court, describing the agreement as “illegal” and “arbitrary,” and has requested that it be cancelled.


Further controversy has arisen following allegations from the United States government that the then Chief Minister, Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, accepted a bribe of ₹1,750 crore in connection with the agreement. A case related to this matter has been filed in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York.

In light of these serious developments, an all-party round table conference is being organized to explore ways to pressure the government to withdraw from the agreement. All major political parties have been invited, and the following individuals have confirmed their participation:
